

Information & Requirements for Vacation Care

The OSHC team are excited to offer several new experiences this Vacation Care. Activities include a new incursion & two new excursion locations. A wide variety of physical, cultural & creative activities have been programmed each day.

Food

 We now provide breakfast & a small afternoon snack each day. However children are required to bring a healthy nutritious lunch box, with morning tea, lunch & afternoon tea, as our days are busy and children get hungry.

Clothing

- Children are required to wear sunsafe clothes and enclosed appropriate shoes during Vacation Care.
- If clothes are not suitable, parents and carers will be called to provide alternate clothing for their children.

Medication

- A medical management plan is required for any child that has any medical diagnosis and requires us to administer prescribed medication in our care including asthma and allergies.
- Medication MUST be in original packaging and an authorisation form must be completed and signed at time of booking.

Devices

- Please do not bring mobile phones or electronic games to Vacation Care.
- We do not accept the responsibility for any personal item that is lost or broken within our care.

- We operate Vacation Care out of Our Lady of the Rosary, Primary School, Wyoming.
- The service opens at 6:30am and closes at 6:30pm.
